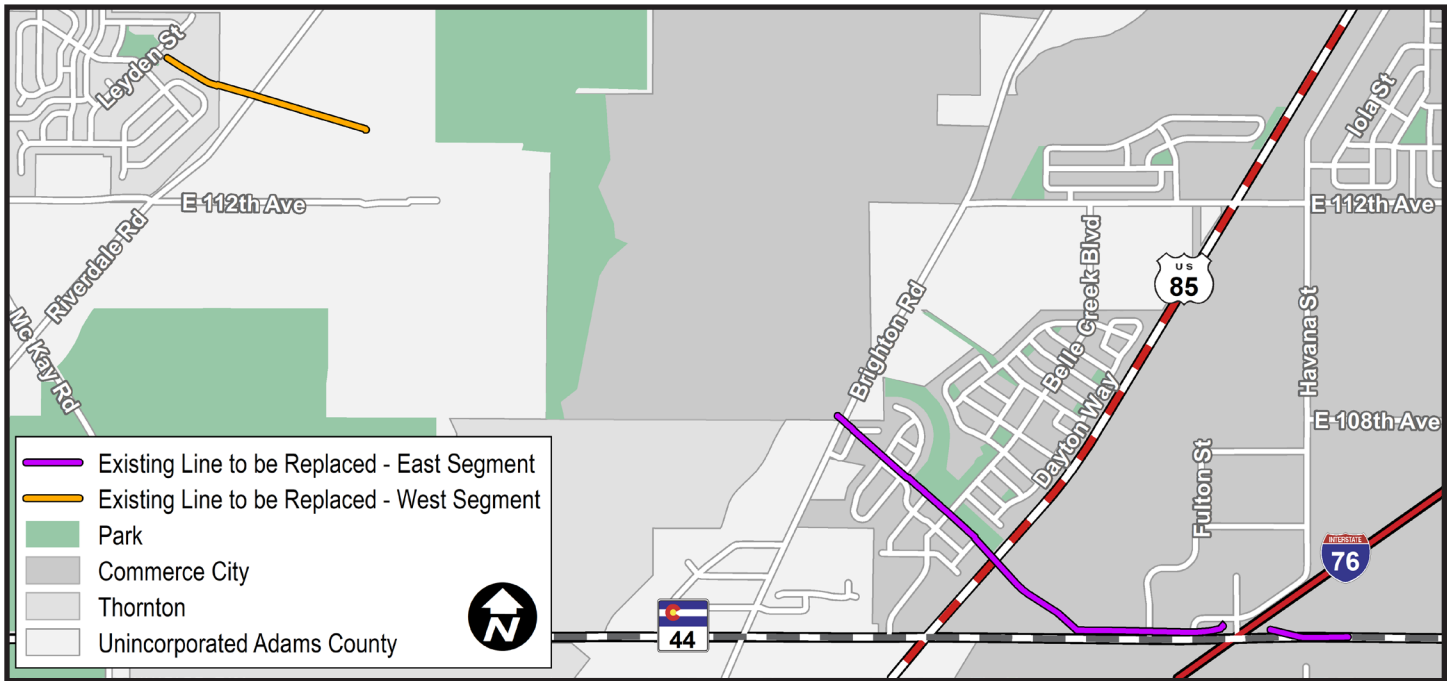


I-76 TO LEYDEN STREET STREET NATURAL GAS PROJECT

Project Overview

Xcel Energy is replacing approximately 1.6 miles of 10-inch natural gas line in parts of Commerce City, Thornton, and Adams County, Colorado, known as the I-76 to Leyden Street Natural Gas Project. This infrastructure replacement project is part of Xcel Energy's commitment to system revitalization, and ensures continued safe, reliable natural gas service to our customers.

Construction began February 2021 and will continue into late 2021. We are installing the west segment first, and the east segment second. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change. We are installing the new natural gas line in the same area as the existing line. Xcel Energy is working with applicable jurisdictions to meet all requirements.

Safety

Public safety is at the foundation of all we do. The safety of the public around Xcel Energy's natural gas system influences every decision we make when we construct and operate natural gas facilities.

The I-76 to Leyden Street Natural Gas Project is designed to meet federal, state, and Xcel Energy standards and safety requirements for installing, maintaining and operating natural gas infrastructure.
