Construction

Construction is expected to begin in the coming weeks and through winter 2026. Schedules are subject to change.

During work, you may notice:

- Marking of utility lines and utility survey holes
- Road and sidewalk closures with parking restrictions
- Temporary changes to access
- Construction noise
- Work area restoration as weather allows

We will install the natural gas line by open trenching.



Overview

Xcel Energy will construct a new natural gas regulator station east of the intersection of West 31st Avenue and Fox Street in Denver for the Fox Street Natural Gas Project. The new natural gas regulator station will replace the existing regulator station near the intersection of West 29th Avenue and Galapago Street to increase system capacity.

This work allows us to continue to provide safe, reliable natural gas service and enhance system resiliency during extreme weather.
