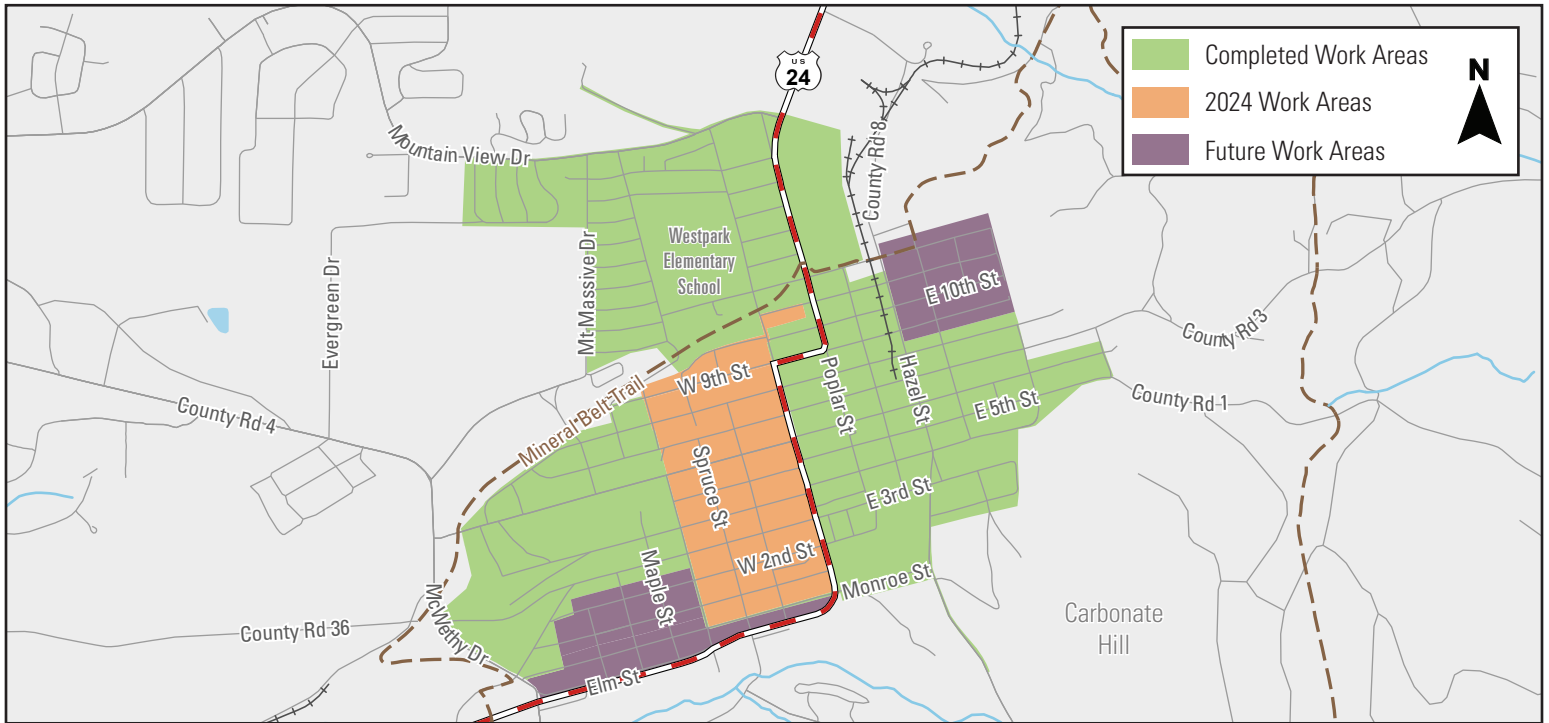


LEADVILLE NATURAL GAS PROJECT

Overview

We continue to construct a multi-year natural gas project in Leadville and unincorporated Lake County.



The Leadville Natural Gas Project includes replacing, relocating and installing new natural gas lines, replacing service lines that serve individual properties and relocating natural gas meters as needed. This work allows us to continue to provide safe, reliable natural gas service and enhances system resiliency during extreme weather.

Construction began in 2019 and is expected to continue through 2025. Construction in 2024 will start on April 29 and continue through September. Schedules are subject to change.

Construction

During work, you may notice:



- Marking of utility lines and utility survey holes.
- Road, sidewalk and alley closures.
- Traffic control.
- Parking restrictions.
- Construction noise.
- Temporary changes to access.

Please alert on site traffic control staff if you need to access a location within a road, sidewalk or alley closure area during construction.

We restore work areas to preconstruction conditions as weather allows. Work areas may be left temporarily restored after construction until we can complete final restoration.
