NATURAL GAS TESTING ACTIVITIES

What to Expect

On Monday, July 24, 2023 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., we will conduct natural gas flaring activities near the intersection of Soda Creek Road and Montane Drive. Flaring is a procedure required to safely empty the existing natural gas line prior to construction activities. Schedules are subject to change.



No customer outages are expected to occur in association with this work.

If you are outside while flaring occurs, you might:

- See a flame at the work area.
- Smell the odorant added to natural gas, which has a sulfur or "rotten egg" odor, though it may smell differently to you.
- Hear elevated levels of noise.

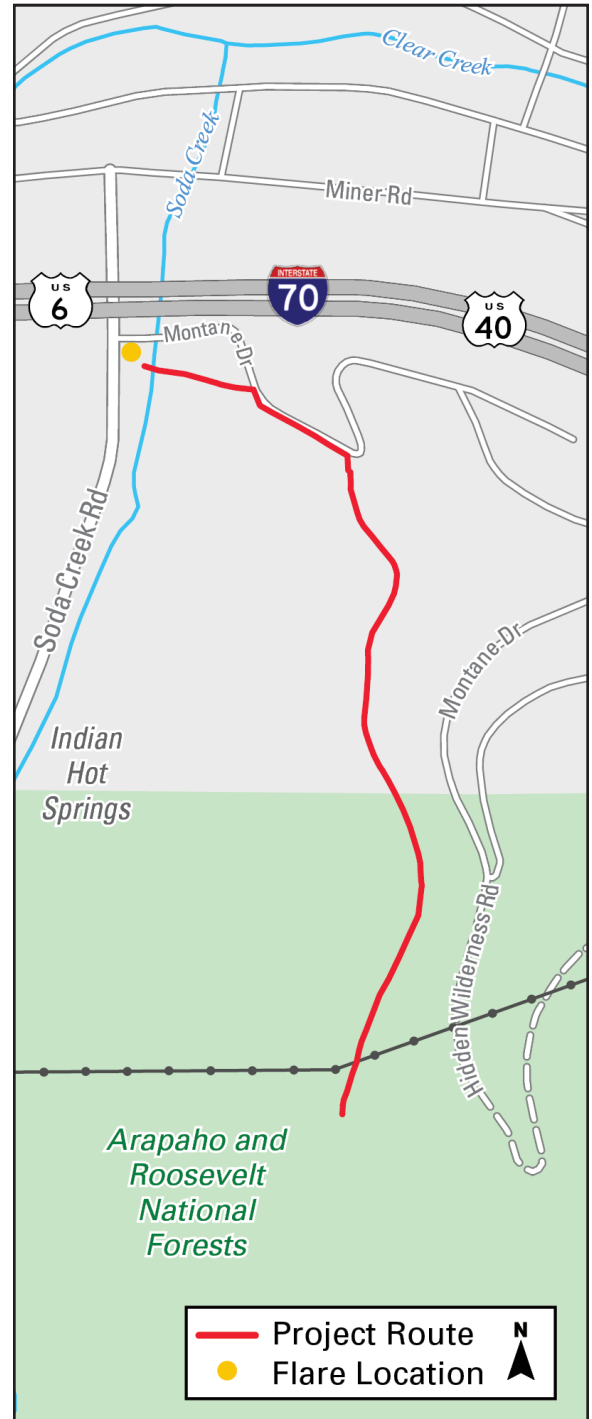
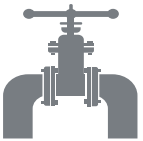
Overview

We will replace approximately 550 feet of natural gas line and pressure test 1,500 feet of existing natural gas line south of and adjacent to Montane Drive and east of Soda Creek Road in Idaho Springs, Colorado.

This maintenance project allows us to continue to provide safe, reliable natural gas service and enhances system resiliency during extreme weather.
